The Honourable Mr Justice David Lok (LLB 1987, PCLL 1988)
Court of First Instance, High Court

Mr Justice Lok obtained his LLB and PCLL from HKU, his LLM from LSE in 1989, was in private practice as a barrister from 1990 to 1995, and appointed as Magistrate in 1995, District Judge in 2001, and Judge of the Court of First Instance, High Court, in 2015. In 2019, he was appointed as the first judge in charge of the Intellectual Property list in the High Court.

Mr Tong is an all-rounded IP practitioner who litigates substantially in Hong Kong, China, the US, Europe, Singapore and Australia, listed by the well-respected World Trademark Review as one of the WTR Global Leaders in 2021, and listed in Who's Who Legal (IP) for 2022. He sits on the Board of Directors of the Government-founded Hong Kong Applied Science and Technology Research Institute Company Limited (aka ASTRI) and chairs its IP Working Group. He was the Deputy Chairman of the Copyright Tribunal of the Hong Kong Government from 2011 to 2017.
